

Guest Pet Agreement

At Hotel Figueroa, we welcome our guests traveling with furry family members. We kindly ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1. Pets are defined as non-service animals (dogs or cats).
- 2. For the safety, security, and comfort of all our Guests, we require that pets be **kept on a leash** or in a carrier while in any public area.
- 3. Except for service animals, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, we do not permit pets in the lounge/restaurant. Emotional Support animals are also not permitted in the lounge / restaurant since they do not qualify as a service animal as defined under the ADA.
- 4. Pets weighing over 50 lbs. are not allowed on the property. Pets must be present at check-in to be registered, and visible to your front desk agent.
- 5. Pets may NOT be left unattended in guest rooms.
- 6. The pet owner must be aware of the \$50 non-refundable fee per pet for allowing the pet onto the property, as well as other fees that may apply to be charged in the event of damage (maximum 2 pets per room).
- 7. The pet owner must properly remove and dispose of any litter or waste associated with my pet on Hotel premises. We have created a green space in our valet lot for a designated pet relief area.
- 8. The Hotel retains the right to exclude a pet if, in the Hotel's sole discretion, the pet is considered dangerous by reason of size, disposition, or is likely to frighten or harm other guests of the Hotel
- 9. The pet owner agrees to be responsible for the noise my pet creates and will ensure that the pet does not disrupt the quiet enjoyment of other hotel guests.

The pet owner is solely responsible and agrees he/she shall not hold the Hotel and/or its Team Members responsible for any damages or injuries done to the property and/or another guest by the pet. The pet owner agrees to hold harmless, indemnify and defend the Hotel against any and all claims, suits, damages, costs, or legal expense as result of bodily injury or property damage resulting from the pet's actions or the pet owner's negligence.
